



OPEN CALL FOR ARTISTS

Artreach Teaching Programmes 2023

We invite proposals from artist-educators working and based in Delhi NCR, Mumbai, Patna, Varanasi, Kashmir and Madhya Pradesh to lead our various upcoming and ongoing teaching programmes.

We are looking for artists to lead on-ground workshops in collaboration with our partnering organisations in care homes, learning centres and schools. Artreach teaching programmes aim to bring joy, confidence and creative skills to children and young people through inspiring art workshops using creative methodologies.

We are looking for artist educators who:

- Have had training in visual arts, design, animation, puppetry, theatre or related fields and come rich with creative skills ranging from basic drawing and painting to specialisations such as sculpture, film making, craft work.
- Are well versed in the basics of art theory, aesthetics and art history and can communicate these in inspiring ways to young people.
- Have a minimum of one year of creative teaching experience, in formal or informal spaces.
- Have some experience of working with under-resourced communities.
- Are sensitive and responsive to the needs, concerns and questions of young people, and are good communicators.
- Applying artists must be 18 years of age or above and residents of India.

To Apply, please email us the following compiled in a single PDF in Hindi/English:

1. A statement of intent (500 words - *outlining who you are, where you are based, why you would like to do this, previous teaching experience or previously designed art education modules*).
2. Detailed Curriculum Vitae.
3. Link to a portfolio or a maximum of 10 images of your work.
4. Documentation of previously conducted art workshops/teaching sessions.

We will review and reply to applications within 90 days from the date of application received.

The selected artist educators will:

- Receive a fixed grant for leading these planned teaching programmes.
- Lead on-ground workshops in the coming year in Delhi NCR/ Mumbai/ Patna, Varanasi / Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh.
- Design original learning modules, curate inspiring images, videos, illustrated books and other content that may be shared/presented in workshops.
- Put together innovative interaction techniques, games and icebreakers that will build a space of trust and create joy.
- Work with the Artreach team in monitoring the progress of your workshops, and be flexible to changes as required for the community.
- Coordinate with the collaborators, local organisation's staff and Artreach team, for all workshops, and during the planning period.
- Submit a 2 page reflection document at the end of the programme period.

About Artreach:

We work with contemporary and traditional Indian and international artists and partner with NGOs, schools, foundations and museums. Our **Teaching Programmes** support artists to work with children and young people from disadvantaged backgrounds who have a talent and passion for art; in the Artroom young people explore opportunities, hone skill sets and work with mentors towards careers in the arts. We support long-term **Community Projects** and interventions, often in difficult or remote areas, where art is used to foster community cohesion. **Artreach Intensives** result in lively murals painted by children in their homes, schools and community spaces.
